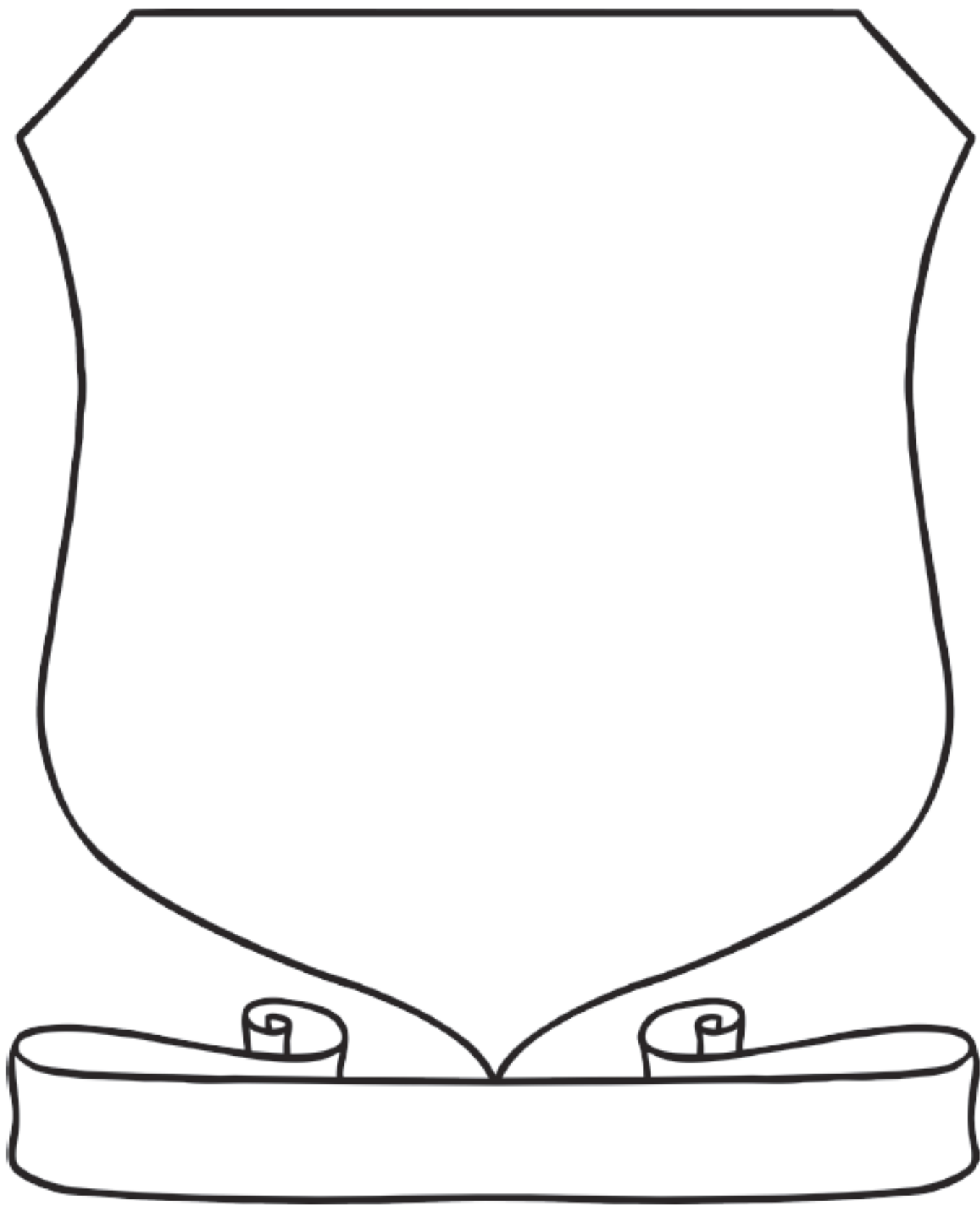

Task 1 - Aircraft in World War II

Task 2 - Propaganda during World War II

Propaganda is a way of communicating with people that aims to convey a particular message and tries to influence how people view things. It was often used during WWII in the form of posters. Have a look at some of the posters at the link below.
