he has not even seen a cow before. He
does not know how to read or write.
I am happy we did not grow up or live
in London. He does not look like a good child
or his parent did not grow him up the right way.
He has not eaten late before he dropped
a potato when he I cooked because he has
not had one before. Even though, I love Willie
you are the most important thing I have
ever had. Willie is a strange but good child.
