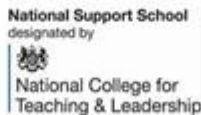

A reminder that everyone should be parking properly in the mornings to drop off their child and not just pulling up in the road/entrance to school. Thank you.

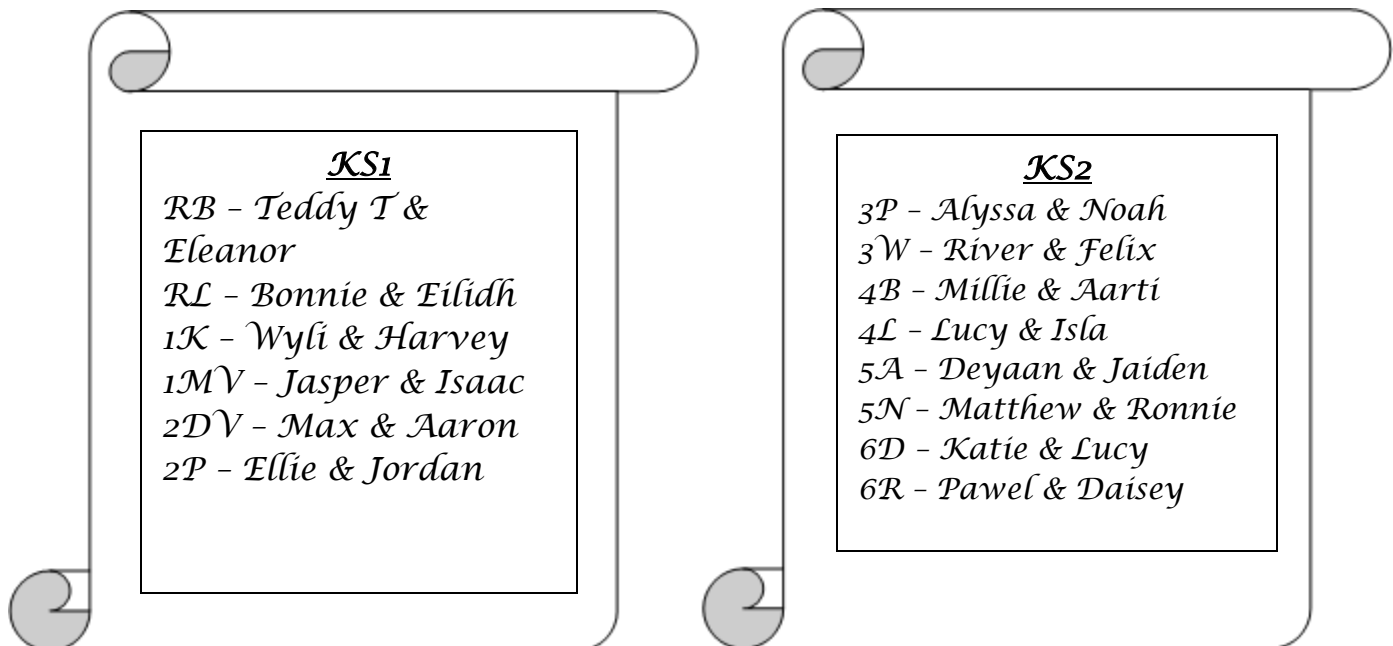
October Half Term Activities
