

Coffee Afternoon & Recycling Event




Wednesday 22nd November 2:30pm – 3:10pm Family Centre Room

Know Your Rights

The Care Act 2014 and The Children and Families Act 2014

These are two of the Acts that are most useful when discussing carer rights. The Care Act is specifically for adults caring for adults and the Children and Families Act applies the law to adults caring for children and young carers under the age of 18.

Carers have the right to:


- Be identified as a carer
- Determine self-willingness and ability to care ,not for it to be assumed
- Decide which needs of the person you care for you are willing and able to support
- Receive a Carer's Assessment
- Work, education, training and leisure
- Discuss flexible working options
- Be consulted on hospital discharge

• Have emergency time off from work to attend to a dependent Under *The Care Act 2014* carers are afforded the same protection from harm in law as those they care for and protection from the impact of caring.
