### Communication, Language & Literacy:

Last week in class we talked about emotions and read the book The Colour Monster which explores feelings and colours in a fun, gentle way. We also discussed strategies to help regulate our emotions when we are experiencing negative feelings such as anger or sadness.

This week:

- We will share the story 'Naughty Bus' and talk about the story.
- We will make predictions about what might happen next in a story.
- We will continue to practise sounding out CVC, CVCC and CCVC words when reading and writing.

# Maths:

- We are continuing to count forwards and backwards to/from 20
- We are learning to find the number 'one more' than another number to 10, then 20.



#### Other Areas of Learning:

- PSHE: Dreams and goals Discussing and exploring perseverance
- Understanding the World: Exploring local transport modes and sharing how we travel to school every day.
- Arts: Making a bus using junk modelling materials
- P.E: Exploring safe moving and balancing in the hall
