Dear Reception Families,

The children had a wonderful time last week learning about planes and creating some fantastic writing linked to this topic; plane tickets, onboard menus, luggage tags, passports and flight safety rules! In maths the children secured their understanding of the word 'altogether' to solve number stories and find totals using counting resources.

Reading

The children's reading is coming along amazingly and we can tell that there has been lots of reading practice going on at home. Even a few pages a day makes a difference! We will continue to teach new digraphs but the whole of next term is consolidation of all these sounds so there will be plenty of time to practice their phonics learning and build reading fluency. Please keep up the reading at home and keep the reading backs in school book bags.

Learning

Our topic this half term is Travel and Transport. Last week the children were exposed to new vocabulary such as security, captain, take off, landing, departure and passenger. Some chose to engage in some plane role-play and demonstrated their understanding by using these words in context.

Communication, Language & Literacy:

This week we will include the following in our learning:

- Read and share 'Astro Girl' and then ask children appropriate questions about the story.
- Discussing 'what is space?' and writing about travelling to space.
- Continuing to practise sounding out CVC, CVCC and CCVC words when reading and writing.

Maths:

This week is Saxon Maths Week!

- P.E: We are learning to develop overall body strength, co-ordination, balance and agility.
