TERM FOCUS

This term we will continue learning about the Romans and life in the Roman times. The children will complete an overlapping collage of a Roman scene in Art to develop this skill.


Forces and Magnets will be studied in Science and the young scientists will continue to develop their Science skills in practical enquiries.

In DT the children will learn how to create a lever and develop their annotated drawing skills too.

READING

Children in Year 3 are expected to read out loud for **at least 10 minutes every day**. Irrespective of their ability, hearing a story is also useful to broaden their vocabulary. It is important for children to reflect on and discuss what they have read to check their understanding.

An important part of reading in Key Stage 2 is comprehension. To help your child progress, please use the question prompts within their reading records or journals.



WRITING

The children's edition of Julius Caesar will be studied in English.

Spelling is an important focus and please can you support your child with any high frequency words that you notice them spelling incorrectly or those from the Year 2 and 3 spelling lists.

High expectations of correctly sized, cursive handwriting, will continue in our handwriting lessons. The use of accurate punctuation and using conjunctions to join sentences are expected. Ambitious vocabulary is continued to be learnt and applied. Full information and how to help your child with writing is available on the learning section of the website.



MATHS



This half term ,Year 3 will be taking part in the Times Table Rockstar's competition against the schools in the Lumen learning Trust. Please let us know if you need to be reminded of your child's TTR's login.

This term the children will learn about length and perimeter, followed by fractions.
