Dear Year 3 Families,

I am delighted to offer your child the opportunity to attend **six** Forest School sessions this Summer term.

Forest School runs on **Wednesday, Thursday** and **Friday** afternoons from 1:30 through to 3pm. Your child is in **Group 3** and their sessions will run from the **15**<sup>th</sup> **May through to the 24**<sup>th</sup> **May.** 

Forest School is a child-led, purposeful experience, which will help the children to develop their resilience, confidence and self-esteem whilst being outside and learning about the diverse natural environment that surrounds them. Acticities they will be taking part in include: den building, tree climbing, learning about life-cycles, habitats, and UK flora and fauna, using tools, playing with mud, and creating woodland arts and crafts.

Forest School sessions run whatever the weather (excepting high winds or electrical storms), therefore your child will need appropriate clothing as listed below:

- 1. Wellies or outdoor waterproof boots / shoes / trainers 3
- 2. <u>Waterproof trousers these are an important item of clothing as they are protective against stinging nettles. If you have trouble obtaining any, please do let me know as I have a small store of spare clothing</u>
- 3. An underlayer: tracksuit bottoms, leggings or thermals
- 4. Long sleeved top
- 5. A jumper/cardigan
- 6. Waterproof coat
- 7. Hat and gloves (weather permitting) / sun hat / sun screen

Please ensure all items are labelled!
