Charles Darwin.

Charles Darwin was a naturalist, scientist, geologist and ~~biologist~~ ^{biologist}. He had ten children and without him we would still think that God made the world. Darwin died on the 19th April 1882 from heart failure at the age of seventy-three and was born on 12th February 1809. She made a book called Jurassic coast fossils and although having discovered many pre-historic fossils, she got obtained very little attention whilst she was alive. In 1823 she discovered the Plesiosaur, whilst walking on the beach with her dog Tray.

Without Mary Anning we wouldn't of known what a ^a full Plesiosaur until the late 1900s! In 1828, she discovered the pterodactylus and in 1810-1811 she had the discovery of a full Ichthyosaurus skeleton

Which is now being displayed in the natural history museum (London). Without Mary Anning, we would have no idea about how creatures lived millions of years ago, and how they evolved. We ~~would~~ not even know what a ~~pter~~ Pterodactylus ^{or} Plesiosaur looked like and what they were.
