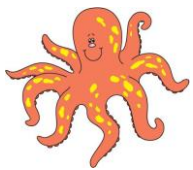
Silly Seaside Maths Challenge!

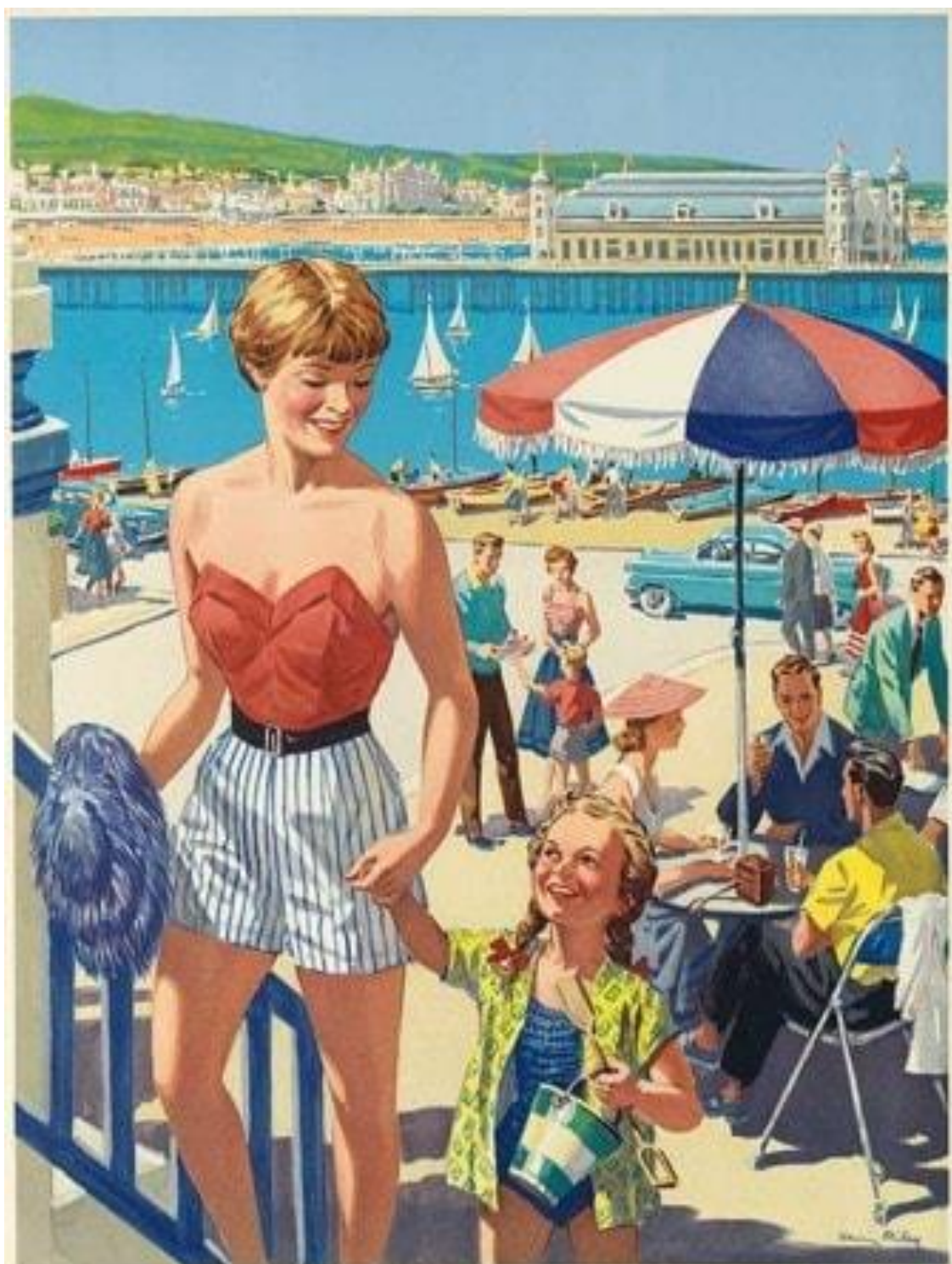

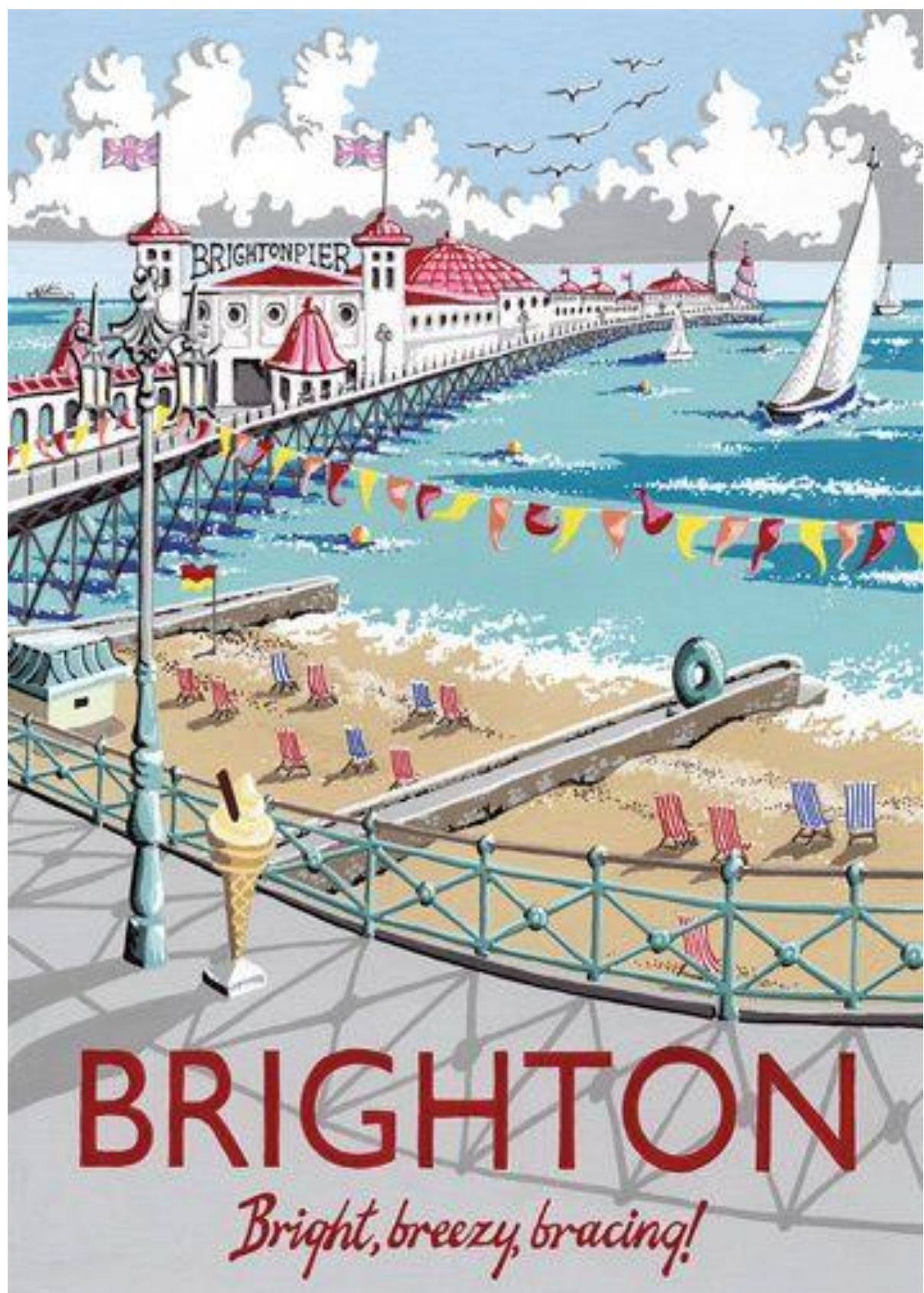

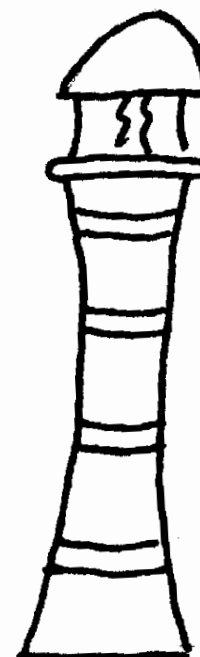
